NOTE.—For single male Attendants, farm workers, and artisans at institutions a deduction of £70 per annum for board and quarters will be made. For Matrons, Cottage Matrons, Sub-Matrons, Cooks, Laundresses, Seamstresses, Attendants, Housemaids, Principals, Vice-Principals, Housemasters, and Housemistresses at institutions a deduction of £70 per annum for board and quarters will be made, or £85 per annum if separate sitting-room provided. In each case the salary shown is subject to the rate of deduction indicated in the "Remarks" column opposite the name of the individual officer.
