

The Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943.—Notice of Intention to Take Land and an Interest in Land

THE Minister of Lands, acting in pursuance of section 24 of the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943, as extended by the provisions of section 2 of the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Amendment Act, 1948, hereby gives notice of his intention to take, under Part II of the said Act, the lands described in the First Schedule hereto, and the interest of the lessee or licensee in the lands described in the Second Schedule hereto, and specifies the 1st day of June, 1950, as the date on which possession of the lands described in the said First and Second Schedules is required, and the 31st day of August, 1950, as the date on or before which objections may be made under section 25 of the said Act.

FIRST SCHEDULE

SOUTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

ALL that parcel of land containing by admeasurement two hundred (200) acres, more or less, being Section 11, Block X, Wharekawa Survey District, and being all of the land described in Certificate of Title, Volume 910, folio 77 (Auckland Registry).

Exemption Order Under the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940

PURSUANT to the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940, the Minister of Transport doth hereby order and declare that the provisions of clause (1) of regulation 7 of the said regulations so far as they relate to the driving of heavy trade motors, shall not apply to the persons hereinafter mentioned, but in lieu thereof the following provision shall apply:—

A motor-driver's licence issued under the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940 to any one of the persons described in Column 1 of the Schedule hereunder may authorize him to drive a heavy trade motor in the course of his employment on a farm or market-garden of the respective employer described in Column 2 of the said Schedule, but shall not authorize him, while he is under the age of eighteen years, to drive a heavy trade motor for any other purpose.
