#### B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General [L.S.] A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of the Midland Railway.

## SCHEDULE

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land: 17 perches. Being Crown land, being formerly road closed by a Proclamation dated the 23rd day of March, 1950, published in the New Zealand Gazette, 1950, page 365.

Situated in Waimea County. (S.O. 9619.)

In the Nelson Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L.O. 10393, deposited in the office of the Minister of Railways at Wellington, and thereon coloured green.
