*Prohibition of Issue of Money-orders and Transmission of Postal Correspondence*

**T**HE Postmaster-General of the Dominion of New Zealand having reasonable ground for supposing that the person and organization whose names and addresses are shown in the Schedule hereunder are engaged in promoting or carrying out a lottery or scheme of chance, it is hereby ordered under section 32 of the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, that no money-order in favour of the said person or of the said organization shall be issued, and that no postal packet addressed to the said person or the said organization (either by his or its own or any fictitious or assumed name) or directed to the addresses mentioned in the Schedule hereunder without a name, shall be registered or forwarded by the post-office of New Zealand.
