*Notice of Intention to Take Land in Block III, Halswell Survey District, for Road*

*Declaring Area to be a Closely Populated Locality for the Purposes of Section 36 of the Transport Act, 1949*

IN terms of section 36 of the Transport Act, 1949, the Minister of Transport doth hereby declare the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a closely populated locality for the purposes of the said section to the intent that a person driving any motor-vehicle on any road therein shall be subject to the maximum speed limit of thirty miles an hour fixed by the said section.

SITUATED within Rangiora County—

All that area at Woodend consisting of—

- (1) The Picton-Christchurch State Highway No. 51, commencing at a point 3 chains measured along the said State highway in a southerly direction from its junction with the Woodend Pound Main Highway No. 610, and terminating at a point 12 chains measured along the said State highway in a north-easterly direction from its junction with the Rangiora-Woodend Main Highway No. 201, a distance of approximately 60 chains.
- (2) The Rangiora-Woodend Main Highway No. 201, commencing at its junction with the Picton-Christchurch State Highway No. 51, and terminating at a point 4 chains measured along the said main highway in a westerly direction from the said junction.
