## A PROCLAMATION

**P**URSUANT to section 450 of the Maori Land Act, 1931, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Maori land described in the Schedule hereto is vested in His Majesty the King.

ALL that piece of land containing 4 acres 2 roods 24 perches, more or less, called or known as Maungatautari 4H 5B 1 Block, situated in Blocks IX and XIII, Maungatautari Survey District, being the residue of the land comprised in Certificate of Title, Volume 293, folio 261 (Auckland Registry).
