Cap: Mid-grey.

Socks: Mid-grey; on turnover, one  $\frac{1}{4}$  in. gold band between two  $\frac{3}{8}$  in. saxe-blue bands, each  $\frac{1}{8}$  in. distant from the gold band.Tie: Alternate diagonal mid-grey and saxe-blue stripes each 1 in. wide. Running through the centre of each saxe-blue stripe, three  $\frac{1}{8}$  in. gold stripes  $\frac{1}{8}$  in. apart.

## Badge

On saxe-blue shield edged in gold, the monogram "MDHS" in gold letters. Beneath the monogram a gold scroll bearing the motto "Age Quod Agis" in saxe-blue letters.
