WHEREAS by an Order in Council dated the 29th day of September, 1948, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the 30th day of that month, the control of the land described in the Schedule to that document, being a reserve for a site for a public hall and library, was vested in certain persons therein named, who were by the said Order in Council constituted a special Board, by the name of the Waitaanga Public Hall and Library Board, in pursuance of section 17 of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928:
