

Appointing the Registration Office for the Mackenzie Branding Registration District.—(Notice No. Ag. 4920)

WHEREAS it is expedient that the place appointed to be the registration office for the Mackenzie Branding Registration District as defined by Warrant under the hand of the Governor dated the 18th day of December, 1915, be changed from the City of Timaru as set out in the said Warrant to the Township of Fairlie:

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the Stock Act, 1908, do hereby appoint the Township of Fairlie to be the registration office for the Mackenzie Branding Registration District, as defined in the said Warrant, in lieu of the City of Timaru, being the place hitherto appointed as the registration office for the said district; and I do hereby declare that this Warrant shall come into operation on the 1st day of November, 1950.

Land Reserved in the Nelson Land District

WHEREAS by section 167 of the Land Act, 1948, it is enacted that the Governor-General may from time to time set apart as a reserve, notwithstanding that the same may be then held under pastoral lease or pastoral occupation licence, any Crown land for any purpose which, in his opinion, is desirable in the public interest, and notice thereof shall be published in the *New Zealand Gazette*:

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the said Act, do hereby reserve the land in the Nelson Land District, described in the Schedule hereto, for a site for a war memorial hall.

SCHEDULE

NELSON LAND DISTRICT

ALL that area containing by admeasurement 9.9 perches, more or less, being part Section 3, Square 93, situated in Block V, French Pass Survey District, and being all the land shown on a plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at Nelson, under No. 3973. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 6/6/879A, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon edged red.
