Notice of Result of Poll on Proposal to Raise a Loan

PURSUANT to section 13 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, I hereby give notice that a poll of the ratepayers of the Borough of Pahiatau, taken on the 23rd day of August, 1950, on the proposal of the Borough Council to borrow the sum of four thousand five hundred pounds for the purpose of building a women's rest room, constructing, kerbing, channelling, and sealing approximately 154 chains of footpaths in the Borough (including portion of southern end of Main Street), forming and sealing paths in two of the Garden Squares, enlarging the outlet of the Huxley Street drain, and making any other Borough capital improvements.
