**P**URSUANT to the Harbours Act, 1923, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby license and permit the Stewart Island Fish Packing and Storage Company, Limited (hereinafter called the Company, which term shall include its successors or assigns, unless the context requires a different construction), to use and occupy a part of the foreshore in Half Moon Bay, Stewart Island, as shown on plan marked M.D. 5502 and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, for the purpose of maintaining a boat slip thereon as shown on the said plan, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the Company upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

3. The term of the licence shall be fourteen years from the 1st day of October, 1950.
