Extract from the minutes of the Inglewood County Council in respect of a meeting held by the Council on the 14th day of August, 1950.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Inglewood County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £10,000, authorized to be raised by the Inglewood County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of making advances to farmers for the erection of dwellings under the Rural Housing Act, 1939, such loan being called the 'Rural Housing Loan No. 2, 1950,' the said Inglewood County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal three thousand six hundred and fourteen pence (·3614d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Inglewood County; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during
