Notice of Intention to Issue an Order in Council Revoking the Reservation Over Portions of the Winton Domain, Southland Land District

WHEREAS by section 41 of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), it is provided that the Governor-General may from time to time by Order in Council, but subject to compliance with the requirements of subsection (2) of section 7 of the said Act, declare that the land comprised in a public domain or part thereof shall cease to be subject to Part II of the said Act; and, further, may declare either that such land shall be a public reserve for the purposes of Part I of the said Act, or Crown land available for disposal by way of sale for cash under the Land Act, 1948:

And whereas the lands described in the Schedule hereto are portions of the Winton Domain but are not required for domain purposes, and it is expedient to revoke the reservation over the said lands:

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby give notice, pursuant to subsection (2) of section 7 of the said Act, that it is my intention to issue an Order in Council under the provisions of section 41 of the said Act declaring that the portions of the Winton Domain described in the Schedule hereto shall cease to be subject to Part II of the said Act, and shall be deemed to be Crown lands available for disposal by way of sale for cash under the Land Act, 1948.

Notice of Intention to Issue an Order in Council Revoking the Reservation for Recreation Purposes over a Reserve in the City of Christchurch, Canterbury Land District

WHEREAS by subsection (1) (b) of section 7 of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), it is provided that the Governor-General may, from time to time, by Order in Council, revoke the reservation over any public reserve or part thereof, and thereupon the land comprised therein shall, if vested in the Crown or in any local authority, or trustees deriving title from the Crown, become Crown land available for disposal under the Land Act, 1948:

And whereas the land described in the Schedule hereto is a reserve duly set apart for recreation purposes but is not required for that purpose, and it is expedient to revoke the reservation over the said land:

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby give notice, pursuant to subsection (2) of section 7 of the said Act, that it is my intention to issue an Order in Council under the provisions of subsection (1) (b) of section 7 of the said Act declaring that the reservation for recreation purposes over the land described in the Schedule hereto shall be revoked.
