KIWITEA COUNTY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING AND LEVYING SPECIAL RATE

The Workers' Dwellings Loan, 1950, of £9,000

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Kiwitea County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of nine thousand pounds (£9,000) authorized to be raised by the Kiwitea County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing workers' dwellings or sites therefor, and/or for erecting workers' dwellings on any sites purchased, acquired, or appropriated for the purpose by the said Council or for any other purpose within the scope of section 192 of the Counties Act, 1920, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-nineteenth of a penny ($\frac{1}{19}$ d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the County of Kiwitea and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
