A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for soil-conservation and river-control purposes; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 20th day of November, 1950.

PURSUANT to section 19 of the Housing Improvement Act, 1945, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim the area defined in the Schedule hereto to be a reclamation area under Part II of the said Act.

ALL that piece of land situate in the City of Auckland bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of Nelson Street and Beresford Street; thence in a north-easterly direction along the north-western side of Nelson Street to Fanshawe Street; thence in a westerly direction along the southern side of Fanshawe Street to Halsey Street; thence in a southerly direction along the eastern side of Halsey Street to its intersection with Victoria Street West; thence by a right line to the southern side of Victoria Street West;
