(1) Alter and redefine the boundaries of the Kekerangu Rabbit District by adding thereto the area of land the boundaries of which are described in the First Schedule hereto;

(2) Declare that the boundaries of the said district as so altered and redefined shall be those set forth in the Second Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARIES OF THE AREA TO BE ADDED TO THE KEKERANGU RABBIT DISTRICT

ALL that parcel of land in the Kaikoura County containing an area of 750 acres, more or less, and bounded as follows: Commencing at Trig. Station W.H., Mount Whernside, in Block VIII, Whernside at Trig. Station W.H., Mount Whernside, in Block VIII, Whernside Survey District; thence proceeding in a westerly direction by a right line to the easternmost corner of part Section 8, Block VIII, aforesaid; thence north-westerly by the north-eastern boundary of the said part Section 8 to the Nidd Stream; thence north-easterly by the said Nidd Stream to its source in Block III, Whernside Survey District; thence south-westerly by a right line to Trig Station W.H., the point of commencement.
