PURSUANT to section 5 of the Maori Purposes Act, 1937, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby set apart and reserve the Maori freehold land described in the Schedule hereto as a Maori reservation for the common use of the Maori residents of the Waotu District and their descendants, as a burial-ground.

ALL that area in the Auckland Land District, situate in Block XVI of the Maungatautari Survey District, containing by admeasurement 2 acres, more or less, being the Maori Land Court subdivision known as Waotu North 2r. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan numbered M.L. 5221, deposited in the office of the Chief Surveyor, at Auckland, and thereon edged red.
