RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Housing Loan 1949, £6,500

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and in pursuance and exercise of all other powers and authorities enabling it in that behalf the Westland Catchment Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest, principal, and other charges on a special loan of £6,500 authorized to be raised by the Westland Catchment Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of erecting dwelling-houses for the purposes of section 22 of the Finance Act (No. 2), 1947, the said Westland Catchment Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one thirty-second of a penny ($\frac{1}{32}$ nd d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property within the Westland Catchment District; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

EKETAHUNA RABBIT BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1928, and its amendments, and the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and its amendments, and by all other Acts, Powers, and Authorities enabling it in that behalf, the Eketahuna Rabbit Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"For the purpose of providing the charges (principal repayments and interest) on a loan of two thousand two hundred and fifty pounds (£2,250) to be known as the Eketahuna Rabbit Board Housing Loan, 1950, authorized to be raised by the Eketahuna Rabbit Board under the above-mentioned Acts for the purpose of erecting a dwelling-house for the accommodation of its employees on its property in High Street, Eketahuna, the Eketahuna Rabbit Board hereby makes and levies, on the acreage basis, a special rate of one half-penny ($\frac{1}{2}$ d.) per acre upon all the rateable property within the whole of the Eketahuna Rabbit District and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be repayable on the 1st day of April and the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years from the 1st day of April, 1951."
