## A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 31 of the Municipal Corporations Amendment Act, 1948, and section 125 of the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby authorize the Christchurch City Council to permit the laying-off of the proposed streets described in the Schedule hereto at widths for parts of their lengths of less than 66 feet, but not less than 50 feet, subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the said streets within a distance of 48 feet from the centre-lines of the said streets.

PURSUANT to section 31 of the Municipal Corporations Amendment Act, 1948, and section 125 of the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby authorize the Auckland City Council to permit the laying-off of the proposed street first described in the Schedule hereto at a width for part of its length of less than 66 feet, but not less than 45 feet, and of the proposed street secondly described in the said Schedule at a width for part of its length of less than 66 feet, but not less than 54 feet, and of the proposed street thirdly described in the said Schedule at a width for part of its length of less than 66 feet, but not less than 60 feet, subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the said streets within a distance of 48 feet from the centre-lines of the said streets.
