*Withdrawing Land From the Operation of the Kauri-gum Industry Act, 1908*

**W**HEREAS by section 178 of the Land Act, 1948, it is enacted that the Governor-General may, by Order in Council, on the recommendation of the Land Settlement Board, declare that any land comprised in a kauri-gum reserve shall, from a date to be specified in the Order, cease to be subject to the Kauri-gum Industry Act, 1908, and on and after the date so specified, the land to which the Order relates shall become Crown land, subject to the provisions of the Land Act, 1948:

And whereas the Land Settlement Board has recommended that portion of the Te Kopuru No. 3 Kauri-gum Reserve as described in the Schedule hereto, be excepted from the operation of the Kauri-gum Industry Act, 1908, and it is expedient to give effect to such recommendation:

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section 178 of the Land Act, 1948, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, do hereby order and declare that portion of the Te Kopuru No. 3 Kauri-gum Reserve as described in the Schedule hereto, shall, from the 1st day of February, 1951, cease to be subject to the Kauri-gum Industry Act, 1908.
