Declaring Land in Block I, Tarawera Survey District, South Auckland Land District, Vested in the Auckland Education Board as a Site for a Public School, to be Vested in His Majesty the King

[L.S.] B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by subsection (6) of section 5 of the Education Lands Act, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), it is provided that notwithstanding anything contained in any other Act, the Governor-General may from time to time, by Proclamation, declare that any school-site or part of a school-site which in his opinion is no longer required for that purpose shall be vested in His Majesty; and thereupon the school-site, or part thereof, as the case may be, shall vest in His Majesty freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date of the Proclamation.

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by subsection (6) of section 5 of the said Act, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being part of an area vested in the Auckland Education Board as a site for a public school, shall be vested in His Majesty the King, freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date hereof.

SCHEDULE

SOUTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

ALL that area situated in Block I, Tarawera Survey District, containing by admeasurement 1 acre and 43 perches, more or less, being part of Section 1, Block LVIII, Town of Rotorua. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 6/6/254c, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon edged red. (South Auckland plan S.O. 34990.)

Additional Land and an Easement Over Land at Gisborne Taken for the Purposes of the Gisborne-Karaka Railway

[L.S.] B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the

Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of the Gisborne–Karaka Railway, and that an easement over the land described in the Second Schedule hereto vesting in His Majesty the King the full and free liberty, right, licence, and authority in perpetuity to construct and use a right-of-way with the right for His Majesty's servants, agents, workmen, tenants, licensees, and invitees from time to time and at all times by day or by night hereafter to go, pass, and repass with or without horses, or other animals of any kind and/or with or without vehicles or implements of any kind over and along the said land for the purpose of giving access to the land described in the First Schedule hereto from Awapuni Road; is hereby taken for the purposes of the Gisborne–Karaka Railway, such easement to be held appurtenant to the land described in the First Schedule hereto; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 11th day of January, 1951.
