

*Classification of Roads in Manunui Town District*

*Declaring Area to be a Closely Populated Locality for the Purposes of Section 36 of the Transport Act, 1949*

IN terms of section 36 of the Transport Act, 1949, the Minister of Transport doth hereby declare the areas in the Schedule hereto to be closely populated localities for the purposes of the said section to the intent that a person driving any motor-vehicle on any road therein shall be subject to the maximum speed limit of thirty miles an hour by the said section.

All that area adjacent to Christchurch City consisting of those portions of roads hereinafter described—

1. The Marshlands - New Brighton Main Highway No. 256 commencing at the northern boundary of Christchurch City, proceeding thence generally in a north-easterly direction and terminating at the junction of the said main highway with Bower Avenue.
2. Wairakei Road, commencing at its junction with the Ilam Road Main Highway No. 635 and terminating at the junction of the said road with Grahams Road.
3. Winters Road, commencing at its junction with the Picton-Christchurch State Highway No. 51 and terminating at the junction of the said road with Grimsey's Road.

All that area at Stewart's Gully, consisting of Stewart's Gully Road, commencing at its junction with the Picton-Christchurch State Highway No. 51 and terminating at the Government Railway Crossing.
