PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby authorize the Waitara Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as the licensee), subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, to lay, construct, put up, place, and use the electric lines described in the Schedule hereto.

#### CONDITIONS

#### 1. Implied Conditions

The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 and the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935 shall be incorporated in and shall form part of this licence, except in so far as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions

#### 2. LICENCE SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS

In respect of the lines hereby authorized, the licensee shall comply with the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, the Radio Interference Regulations 1934, and with all regulations hereafter made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor respectively.

#### 3. System of Supply

The system of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a) and (f) of clause 21-01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935. The primary distribution voltage shall be 11,000 volts.

## 4. Duration of Licence

This licence shall, unless sooner determined, continue in force until the 7th day of January, 1967.
