#### SPECIAL ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Noxious Weeds Act, 1950, the Waikato County Council hereby resolves and declares, by way of special order, as follows :---

"1. That the undermentioned plants are noxious weeds within the County of Waikato :-
