ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 20th day of March, 1951

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby grant to Henry Sidney Lawrence, of Christchurch, Retired, Frank Sturmer Wilding, of Christchurch, Solicitor, and Alexander Albert Mackintosh, of Rangiora, Farmer (hereinafter referred to as the licensees), as Trustees of the estate of William David Mackintosh, late of Waipara, North Canterbury, Farmer, a licence, subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, to take and use from an unnamed stream (hereinafter referred to as the said stream) situated in R.S. 30607, Block III, Teviotdale Survey District, in the Land District of Canterbury, for the purpose hereinafter set forth, a stream of water not exceeding one cubic foot per second at any one time, and to lay, construct, put up, place, and use the electric lines hereinafter described.

CONDITIONS

1. IMPLIED CONDITIONS

THE conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Water-power Regulations 1934 and the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 shall be incorporated herein and shall form part of this licence, except in so far as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions hereof.

2. LICENCE SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS

This licence is issued under the Water-power Regulations 1934, and is subject thereto and to the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, and the Radio Interference Regulations 1934, and to all regulations hereafter made in amendment thereof or in substitution thereof respectively.

3. UTILIZATION OF WATER AND LOCATION OF HEADWORKS

Water shall be used under this licence solely for the purpose of generating electricity, and shall be taken from the said stream at the point in R.S. 30607, Block III, Teviotdale Survey District, as indicated on the plan marked P.W.D. 86904, deposited in the office of the Minister of Works.
