And whereas it is deemed expedient to alter and redefine the boundaries of the said district accordingly: Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by the said Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Exceutive Council, doth hereby—

(1) Alter and redefine the boundaries of the said district so constituted as aforesaid :

- (2) Declare that the boundaries of the said district shall be those set forth in the Schedule hereto; and, further, (3) Declare that this Order in Council shall come into force on

SCHEDULE
