BAY OF ISLANDS ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Reticulation Extension Loan No. 7 (1951), £60,000

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Bay of Islands Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £60,000 (sixty thousand pounds), authorized to be raised by the Bay of Islands Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of providing additional monies for the further reticulation of the Bay of Islands Electric-power Board District, the said Bay of Islands Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of forty-three one hundredths of one penny ($\frac{43}{100}$ d.) in the pound upon the unimproved value of all rateable property within the Bay of Islands Electric-power District; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 2nd day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 25 (twenty-five) years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
