

WAIROA ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION LEVYING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by section 15 of the Finance Act, 1936 (No. 2), the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Electric-power Boards Act, 1925, and Amendments thereto, and all other Acts and powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Wairoa Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest and sinking fund and other charges on the Reticulation Loan, 1950, authorized to be raised by the said Board under the provisions of the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of extending electric-supply lines and reticulating additional areas of the Board's District, the Board makes and levies a special rate of one thirty-third of a penny ($\frac{1}{33}$ d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Wairoa Electric-power Board District, comprising the County of Wairoa and the Borough of Wairoa as defined in the Proclamation proclaiming the said district appearing in the *New Zealand Gazette* on the 29th day of July, 1920, at page 2257, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty (20) years or until the loan is fully paid off."

"That, for the purpose of providing principal and interest repayments and other charges on a loan of £5,950 known as the "Sewerage Loan, 1950," authorized to be raised by the Board under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, for the purpose of extensions, renewals, and improvements to the sewerage system within the Town Board's district, the Havelock North Town Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one penny (1d.) in the pound (£) on the rateable unimproved value of all rateable property in the Havelock North Town District, and that such special rate be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years or until the loan is fully repaid."
