Declaring Land in North Auckland and Nelson Land Districts, Vested in the Auckland and Nelson Education Boards as Sites for Public Schools, to be Vested in His Majesty the King

#### B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by subsection (6) of section 5 of the Education
Lands Act, 1949 (hereimafter referred to as the said Act),
it is provided that notwithstanding anything contained in any
other Act, the Governor-General may from time to time, by Proclamation declare that any school-site or part of a school-site which
in his opinion is no longer required for that purpose shall be vested
in His Majesty; and thereupon the school-site, or part thereof,
as the case may be, shall vest in His Majesty freed and discharged
from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all
leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyvil Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by subsection (6) of section 5 of the said Act, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the Auckland Education Board, and the land described in the Second Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the Nelson Education Board, as sites for public schools, shall be vested in His Majesty the King, freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date hereof. hereof.
