## OTAMATEA COUNTY COUNCIL

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Otamatea County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £5,000, authorized to be raised by the Otamatea County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of purchasing land and erecting dwellings and purchasing land with dwellings thereon, the said Otamatea County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-fifth of a penny in the pound upon the rateable unimproved value of all rateable property of the County of Otamatea; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”

## KAIKOURA COUNTY COUNCIL

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Kaikoura County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of five thousand pounds (£5,000), authorized to be raised by the Kaikoura County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of meeting the Council's share of the cost of the erection of the Kahutara, Lynton, and Kekeurangi Bridges, the Kaikoura County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of eleven two-hundred-and-fiftieths of a penny (0.044d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the whole of the County of Kaikoura, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of September, in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five (25) years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
