ance with the provisions of the Noxious Weeds Act, 1950.

SPECIAL ORDER

IN exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Noxious Weeds
Act, 1950, the Mount Albert Borough Council hereby resolves and
declares, by way of special order, the plants mentioned in the
Schedule hereto (being plants included in the First Schedule to the
said Act) to be noxious weeds within the Borough of Mount Albert.
