Revoking the Reservation Over Land in Canterbury Land District Reserved for Plantation Purposes

N pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by subsection (4) of section 171 of the Reserves and Other Lands Disposal and Public Bodies Empowering Act, 1924, I, Lieu-tenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the reservation for plantation purposes over the land described in the Schedule hereto.

CANTERBURY LAND DISTRICT

ALL that area situated in Block VII, Fighting Hill Survey District, containing by admeasurement 57 acres 3 roods 25 perches, more or less, being Lot 3 as shown on a plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at Christchurch under No. 3588, and being Reserve 3931; and Lot 8 as shown on the plan deposited as aforesaid under No. 3588, being parts of Rural Sections 19356, 19357, 22673, 27257, and parts of Reserve 1779. Declaring a Portion of Railway Land at Islington to be Crown Land

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land subject to the Land Act, 1948.
