WAIMATE DISTRICT HUNT (INCORPORATED) CLUB REGULATIONS

(Under the Gaming Act, 1908)

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers in that behalf contained in section 33 of the Gaming Act, 1908, and of all other powers and authorities it enabling in that behalf, the Waimate District Hunt (Incorporated) Club, a racing club within the meaning of the said Act (hereinafter referred to as the said Club) doth hereby make the following regulations controlling the admission of persons to that part of the Oamaru Racecourse situated in the district of North Otago and known as the Oamaru Racecourse while the said racecourse is used or occupied by the said club for race meetings.

These regulations shall come into force on the date of the same being published in the New Zealand Gazette.
In these regulations the words "bookmaker," "racing club," and "race meeting" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by section 2 of the Gaming Act, 1908.
The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from the racecourse above described while the same is used or occupied by the said club for a race meeting.

 (d) Common prostitutes and persons who habitually consort with thieves or persons who have no lawful visible means of support :
- of support: (e) Professional tipsters, persons convicted of house-breaking ofessional tipsters, persons convicted of house-breaking or pocket picking, forgery, uttering or possessing counterfeit coin, theft, false pretences, receiving stolen goods, mischief, assault, or any offence or crime of any kind under the Crimes Act, 1908, and also idle and disorderly persons, rogues, and vagabonds, and in-corrigible rogues convicted under the Police Offences Act, 1908, and persons convicted of an offence under the Gaming Act, 1908.

We be the second state of revocation.
