ADDENDUM, 26th January, 1951, to the New Zealand Formulary:—

NEW ZEALAND FORMULARY, PART 2

The reference in this part of the New Zealand Formulary to the First Schedule to the rules of Prescription Pricing shall, where applicable, be deemed to be the Prescription Pricing Supplement 1951/1, issued by the Pharmacy Plan Industrial Committee. This amendment shall take effect with respect to all medical prescriptions and midwifery orders (whatever the date thereof) that are presented to a contractor for fulfilment on or after the 1st February, 1951.
