A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by subsection (1) of section 8 of the Housing Amendment Act, 1940, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare the land described in the Schedule hereto, being land subject to the Housing Act, 1919, to be Crown land available for reservation under the Land Act, 1948.

SCHEDULE

OTAGO LAND DISTRICT

ALL that area containing by admeasurement 1 rood 7-64 perches, more or less, being Lot 172 on a plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at Dunedin under No. 6967, being part Section 1, Block XV, Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District, and being part of the land comprised and described in certificate of title, Volume 339, folio 237 (Otago Registry).

CANTERBURY LAND DISTRICT.—CANTERBURY CONSERVANCY

ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District, Ashburton County, containing by admeasurement 73 acres 1 rood 22 perches, more or less, being part of Reserve 3119, situated in Block VII, Alford Survey District, and bounded generally as follows: Towards the east generally by the Bushy Gully Stream and part of Run 103, 550 links; and towards the south-west, north-west, and north-east by the other part of Reserve 3119 (permanent State forest, *New Zealand Gazette* 1881, page 960), 2328-2 links, 4067-5 links, and 1406-8 links respectively. As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 150/5, deposited in the Head Office of the New Zealand Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.
