A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the lands described in the Schedule hereto are portions of a reserve duly set apart for scenic purposes: And whereas the said lands are no longer suitable for scenic purposes by reason of the absence of bush of scenic value thereon: Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 8 of the Scenery Preservation Amendment Act, 1910, do hereby revoke the reservation for scenic purposes over the lands described in the Schedule hereto.

MARLBOROUGH LAND DISTRICT

ALL those areas containing by admeasurement a total of 2 roods 36 perches, more or less, being parts of Section 71, Block V, Mount Fyffe Survey District. As the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 4/609A, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon edged red. (S.O. plan 3894.)

GOD SAVE THE KING!

Lands Reserved in the North Auckland, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago Land Districts

B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General

WHEREAS by section 167 of the Land Act, 1948, it is enacted that the Governor-General may from time to time set apart as a reserve, notwithstanding that the same may be then held under pastoral lease or pastoral occupation licence, any Crown land for any purpose which, in his opinion, is desirable in the public interest, and notice thereof shall be published in the *New Zealand Gazette*.

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the said Act, do hereby reserve, subject to the reservations and conditions imposed by section 59 of the Land Act, 1948, and subject also to the reservations imposed by section 8 of the Coal Mines Amendment Act, 1950, the lands in the North Auckland, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago Land Districts, described in the Schedule hereunder written, for the purposes specified at the end of the respective descriptions of the lands so intended to be reserved.

SCHEDULE

NORTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

SECTION 32, Block I, Russell Survey District, being Motu Arahi Island: Area, 4 acres and 7 perches, more or less. (S.O. plan 36495s.) (Recreation.)

(L. and S. H.O. 7/864; D.O. 13/35.)

Allotment 121 of Section 6, Suburbs of Auckland, situated in Block XVI, Waitemata Survey District: Area, 27.08 perches, more or less. (S.O. plan 35139s.) (Recreation.)

WELLINGTON LAND DISTRICT
