

## Crown Land Set Apart as Permanent State Forest Land

## A PROCLAMATION

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section 18 of the Forests Act, 1949, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby set apart the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto as permanent State forest land.

## SCHEDULE

## NELSON LAND DISTRICT—NELSON CONSERVANCY

ALL those areas in the Nelson Land District, Waimea County, containing by admeasurement 101 acres 3 roods 31 perches, more or less, situated in Blocks I, II, V, VI, and X, Gordon Survey District, being formerly roads closed by a Proclamation dated the 23rd day of March, 1950, published in *New Zealand Gazette* No. 19, 1950, page 364, and described as follows:—
