Vesting the Control of a Scenic Reserve in the North Shore Scenic Board

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by section 13 of the Scenery Preservation Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, doth hereby vest the control of the reserve described in the Schedule hereto (being land reserved under the said Act), in trust for the purposes of scenery preservation, as from the date of this notice until the 30th day of November, 1954 (unless previously altered or revoked under the said Act), in the North Shore Scenic Board, as constituted by notification dated the 1st day of December, 1949, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the 8th day of that month.

Vesting the Control of Scenic Reserves in the Taihape Borough Council

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by section 13 of the Scenery Preservation Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand doth hereby vest the control of the scenic reserves described in the Schedule hereto (being lands reserved under the said Act) in the Taihape Borough Council, subject to the conditions hereinafter contained, that is to say:—

1. The period for which the control of the reserves is hereby vested shall be ten years from the date hereof, unless the reservation is previously altered or revoked under the said Act.

2. The said Council shall prepare a report each year ending on the 31st day of March, together with a statement of receipts and expenditure in connection with the said reserves. Such report and statement shall be sent to the Minister charged with the administration of the said Act as soon as possible after the close of the year.

3. The said Council shall control the said reserves in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the regulations made thereunder.

WELLINGTON LAND DISTRICT—TAIHAPE SCENIC RESERVES

All that area containing by admeasurement 200 acres 1 rood 6 perches, more or less, being Sections 63, 64, 79, 80, and part Section 62, Block XIV, Ohinewairua Survey District.
