*Proclaiming Maori Land to Have Become Crown Land*

A PROCLAMATION

**P**URSUANT to section 454 of the Maori Land Act, 1931, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, being satisfied that the purchase of the land described in the Schedule hereto has been completed by or on behalf of the Crown under the authority of the said Act, do hereby proclaim that the said land has become Crown land.

SCHEDULE

ALL that parcel of land in the South Auckland Land District, situated in Block III, Piopotea Survey District, containing by admeasurement 98 acres 3 roods 31 perches, more or less, being Ohura South C No. 2, Section 3E No. 1 Block, and being all of the land described in Provisional Register, Volume 120, folio 18 (Auckland Registry).

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the Seal of that Dominion, this 10th day of September 1951.

**I**N pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of the East Coast Main Trunk Railway.
