**P**URSUANT to section 128 of the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby approves of the following resolution passed by the Wellington City Council on the 11th day of April 1951, in so far as it affects the side and portion of street described in the Schedule hereto, viz:—

“The Wellington City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in Wellington City, by resolution declares that the provisions of section 128 of the Public Works Act 1928, shall not apply to the north-west side of the portion of Cecil Road adjoining Lots 1 and 2, D.P. 6419, being all (or part) of the land in certificate of title, Volume 41, folio 94 (Wellington Registry)”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the north-western side of the portion of Cecil Road (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of 25 ft. from the centre-line of the said portion of street.
