- (1) The term for which the said loan or any part thereof may be raised shall not exceed twenty-five (25) years.
- (2) The rate of interest that may be paid in respect of the said loan or any part thereof shall be such as shall not produce to the lender or lenders a rate or rates exceeding three pounds five shillings (£3 5s.) per centum per annum.
- (3) The said loan or any part thereof, together with interest thereon, shall be repaid by equal aggregate annual or half-yearly instalments extending over the term as determined in (1) above.
- (4) The payment of such instalments shall be made in New Zealand and no instalments shall be paid out of loan-moneys
- (5) The rate payable for brokerage, underwriting, and procuration fees in respect of the raising of the said loan or any part thereof shall not in the aggregate exceed one-half per centum of
- (6) No moneys shall be borrowed under this consent after the expiration of two years from the date hereof.
