### 2. LICENCE SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS

In respect of the lines hereby authorized, the licensee shall comply with the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, the Radio Interference Regulations 1934, and with any regulations made or to be made in amendment or amplification thereof or in substitution therefor.

### 3. SYSTEM OF SUPPLY

The system of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a) and (f) of clause 21-01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935. The primary distribution voltage shall be  $3{,}300$  volts.

## 4. Duration of Licence

This licence shall, unless sooner lawfully determined, continue in force until the 21st day of April, 1963.
