Revoking a Notice Declaring Land to be Subject to Part I of the Maori Land Amendment Act 1936 (Maketu Development Scheme)

Officiating Ministers for 1951—Notice No. 35

PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 4 of the Maori Land Amendment Act 1936, the Board of Maori Affairs hereby revokes a notice made on the 11th day of July 1932 and published in *New Zealand Gazette* No. 48 of the 14th day of July 1932, at page 1653, whereby the land known as Pukaingaturu B No. 24F, Section 2, containing 84 acres 3 roods 6 perches, more or less, situate in the Maketu Survey District, was declared to be subject to the provisions of section 522 of the Maori Land Act 1931 (now Part I of the Maori Land Amendment Act 1936).
