PURSUANT to section 5 of the Maori Purposes Act 1939, I, Bernard Cyril, Baron Freyberg, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby declare the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto to be subject to Part I of the Maori Land Amendment Act 1936.

As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 5/47, deposited in the Head Office of the New Zealand Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.
