Land Set Apart as Provisional State Forest Declared to be Subject to the Land Act 1948

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 19 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Bernard Cyril, Baron Freyberg, the Governor-General ■ 1949, I, Bernard Cyril, Baron Freyberg, the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting on the joint recommendation of the Minister of Lands and of the Minister of Forests, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being portion of a provisional State forest reserve set apart by Proclamation dated the 7th day of October 1930 and gazetted on the 9th day of that month, is required for settlement purposes; and, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, such land shall, from and after the day of the gazetting hereof, cease to be provisional State forest land, and shall become Crown land available for sale, leave reservation or other disposition under the provisions of the lease, reservation, or other disposition under the provisions of the Land Act 1948.

SCHEDULE

NELSON LAND DISTRICT

ALL that area containing by admeasurement 70 acres, more or less, being part Section 24, Block IV, Waitakere Survey District. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 10/97/71B, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon edged red. (S.O. plan 7804.)
