WHEREAS by section 178 of the Land Act 1948 it is enacted that the Governor-General may, by Order in Council, on the recommendation of the Land Settlement Board, declare that any land comprised in a kauri-gum reserve shall, from a date to be specified in the Order, cease to be subject to the Kauri-gum Industry Act 1908, and on and after the date so specified, the land to which the Order relates shall become Crown land, subject to the provisions of the Land Act 1948 :

And whereas the Land Settlement Board has recommended that part of the Rotoroa Kauri-gum Reserve as described in the Schedule hereto, be excepted from the operation of the Kauri-gum Industry Act 1908, and it is expedient to give effect to such recommendation :

Now, therefore, pursuant to section 178 of the Land Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby orders and declares that part of the Rotoroa Kauri-gum Reserve as described in the Schedule hereto, shall, from the 1st day of February 1952, cease to be subject to the Kauri-gum Industry Act 1908.
