“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £78,900, authorized to be raised by the Huntly Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for sewerage and waterworks extensions and improvements, the said Huntly Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of seven and decimal one eight three pence in the pound upon the rateable value, on the basis of the unimproved value of all rateable property in the Borough of Huntly, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”
