They will also be liable for the expense of making good any damage done to the Department's rolling-stock in connection with the loading, unloading, or carriage of any circus.

2. Sorting.—(a) Goods ex ship comprising two or more packages or articles hauled and charged for such haulage as per subparagraphs (b) and (c) of paragraph 1 of this regulation, and which require to be sorted out for delivery or for redespatch, will be charged 4s. 6d. per ton, which charge shall include the unloading charge specified in clause (d) of paragraph 1 of this regulation (minimum charge, 2s.).
