Consenting to the Raising of a Loan of £150,000 by the Poverty Bay Electric-power Board and Prescribing the Conditions Thereof

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

WHEREAS the Poverty Bay Electric-power Board (hereinafter called the said local authority), being desirous of raising a loan of one hundred and fifty thousand pounds (£150,000) to be known as "Extensions Loan 1952" (hereinafter called the said loan) for the purpose of further reticulating the Poverty Bay Electric-power District, purchasing office equipment, motor-vehicles and land, and constructing buildings, has complied with the provisions of the Local Government Loans Board Act 1926 (hereinafter called the said Act), and it is expedient that the precedent consent of the Governor-General in Council, as required by the said Act, should be given to the raising of the said loan:
