3. The said loan or any part thereof, together with interest thereon, shall be repaid by equal aggregate annual or half-yearly instalments extending over the term as determined in 1 above.
4. The payment of such instalments shall be made in New Zealand and no such instalment shall be paid out of loan-moneys.
5. The rate payable for brokerage, underwriting, and procuration fees in respect of the raising of the said loan or any part thereof shall not in the aggregate exceed one-half per centum of any amount raised.
6. No moneys shall be borrowed under this consent after the expiration of two years from the date hereof.
